

MINUTES of a regular public meeting of the City Council of the City of Rockford, Winnebago and Ogle Counties, Illinois, held in the Council Chambers on the 2nd Floor of City Hall, 425 East State Street, Rockford, Illinois, in said City at 5:30 p.m., on the ____ day of August, 2026.

* * *

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor, and upon the roll being called, Thomas McNamara, the Mayor, and the following Aldermen were physically present at said location:

The following Aldermen were allowed by a majority of the members of the City Council in accordance with and to the extent allowed by rules adopted by the City Council to attend the meeting by video or audio conference: _____

No Alderman was not permitted to attend the meeting by video or audio conference.

The following Aldermen were absent and did not participate in the meeting in any manner or to any extent whatsoever: _____

The Mayor announced that in order to finance necessary improvements to the waterworks system of the City, it would be necessary for the City to issue revenue bonds therefor and that the City Council would consider the adoption of an ordinance authorizing and providing for the issuance of such bonds.

Whereupon Alderman _____ presented, and the Legal Director as Keeper of the Records and Seal and also the Comptroller read by title an ordinance as follows, a copy of which was provided to each Alderman prior to said meeting and to everyone in attendance at said meeting who requested the same:

ORDINANCE NUMBER _____

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ROCKFORD, WINNEBAGO AND OGLE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, TO BORROW FUNDS FROM THE PUBLIC WATER SUPPLY LOAN PROGRAM AND ISSUE ITS WATERWORKS REVENUE BONDS TO EVIDENCE SUCH BORROWING.

WHEREAS, the City of Rockford, Winnebago and Ogle Counties, Illinois (the “*City*”), is a duly organized and existing municipality and unit of local government created under the provisions of the laws of the State of Illinois and is now operating under the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, as supplemented and amended (the “*Code*”); and

WHEREAS, the City for many years has owned and operated a municipally-owned waterworks system (as herein more fully defined, the “*System*”) in accordance with the provisions of Division 129 of Article 11 of the Code, as supplemented by the Local Government Debt Reform Act, as amended (collectively, the “*Act*”), and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City (the “*Council*”) has determined that it is advisable, necessary and in the best interests of public health, safety and welfare to improve the System, including the following:

Removal and replacement of lead service lines throughout the City, covering multiple phases.

all in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by consulting engineers of the City (the “*Project*”), which Project has a useful life of at least 40 years; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of construction and installation of the Project, including engineering, legal, financial and other related expenses is \$55,000,000, and there are insufficient funds on hand and lawfully available to pay these costs; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and for the best interests of the City that the Project be undertaken and, in order to finance the cost thereof, it will be necessary for the City to issue up to \$55,000,000 bonds payable from the revenues of the System as authorized to be issued at this time pursuant to Division 129 of Article 11 of the Code and Division 4 of Article 8 of the Code (the “*Bonds*”); and

WHEREAS, the City expects to issue all or a portion of the Bonds in connection with one or more loans originated from the “Public Water Supply Program” (the “*Loan Program*”) and offered to the City by the State of Illinois, acting through the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (the “*IEPA*”); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of the Act, the City is authorized to borrow funds from the Loan Program and may issue the Bonds in evidence thereof for the purpose of providing funds to pay the cost of the Project; and

WHEREAS, such loan or loans to the City may be made pursuant to a loan agreement or agreements (the “*Loan Agreementss*”) and bond ordinance or ordinances, with such terms and conditions as may be provided by the IEPA; and

WHEREAS, the Bonds shall bear an interest rate as defined by 35 Ill. Adm. Code 662, which does not exceed the maximum rate authorized by the Bond Authorization Act, as amended, 30 ILCS 305/0.01 *et seq.*, at the time of the issuance of the Bonds; and

WHEREAS, the principal and interest due on the Bonds shall be payable semi-annually, and the Bonds shall mature in up to forty (40) years, which is within the period of useful life of the Project; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Rockford, Winnebago and Ogle Counties, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1

INCORPORATION OF PREAMBLES

The Council hereby finds that the recitals contained in the preambles are true and correct, and incorporates them into this Ordinance by this reference.

SECTION 2

DETERMINATION TO ISSUE BONDS

It is necessary and in the best interests of the City to construct the Project for the public health, safety and welfare, in accordance with the plans and specifications, as described; that the System continues to be operated in accordance with the provision of the Act; and that for the purpose of constructing the Project, it is hereby authorized to be issued and sold the Bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$55,000,000 (which can include construction period interest financed over the term of the Bonds).

SECTION 3

PUBLICATION

This Ordinance, together with a Notice in the statutory form (attached hereto as *Exhibit A*), shall be published once within ten days after passage in the *Rockford Register Star*, a newspaper published and of general circulation in the City, and if no petition, signed by electors numbering 10% or more of the registered voters in the City (*i.e.*, 9,326) asking that the question of improving the System and issuance of the Bonds therefor, as provided in this Ordinance, be submitted to the electors of the City, is filed with the City Clerk within 30 days after the date of publication of this Ordinance and notice, then this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect. A petition form shall be provided by the City Clerk to any individual requesting one.

SECTION 4

ADDITIONAL ORDINANCES

If no petition meeting the requirements of the Act and other applicable laws is filed during the 30-day petition period, then the Council may adopt additional ordinances or proceedings supplementing or amending this Ordinance providing for the issuance and sale of the Bonds, prescribing all the details of the Bonds, so long as the maximum amount of the Bonds as set forth

in this Ordinance is not exceeded and there is no material change in the Project or purposes described herein. Any additional ordinances or proceedings shall in all instances become effective in accordance with the Act or other applicable law. This Ordinance, together with such additional ordinances or proceedings, shall constitute complete authority for the issuance of the Bonds under applicable law and for entering into the Loan Agreements under applicable law. However, notwithstanding the above, the City may not adopt additional ordinances or amendments which provide for any substantive or material change in the scope and intent of this Ordinance, including but not limited to interest rate, preference or priority of any other ordinance with this Ordinance, parity of any other ordinance with this Ordinance, or otherwise alter or impair the obligation of the City to pay the principal and interest due to the Program without the written consent of the IEPA.

SECTION 5

BONDS NOT INDEBTEDNESS OF THE CITY

Repayment of the loan as evidenced by the Bonds to the IEPA by the City pursuant to this Ordinance is to be solely from the revenue derived from revenues of the System, and the Bonds do not constitute an indebtedness of the City within the meaning of any constitutional or statutory limitation.

SECTION 6

APPLICATION FOR LOAN

The Mayor of the City (the “*Mayor*”) is hereby authorized to make application to the IEPA for a loan through the Loan Program, in accordance with the loan requirements set out in 35 Ill. Adm. Code 662.

SECTION 7

ACCEPTANCE OF LOAN AGREEMENTS

The Council hereby authorizes acceptance of the offer of the loan through the Loan Program, including all terms and conditions of the Loan Agreements as well as all special conditions contained therein and made a part thereof by reference, such Loan Agreements to be as further approved by the bond ordinance and related proceedings for the Bonds. The Council further agrees that the loan funds awarded shall be used solely for the purposes of the Project as approved by the IEPA in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Loan Agreements.

SECTION 8

RESERVE ACCOUNTS

As long as the City has outstanding senior bonds that are payable from revenues of the System, the City shall maintain an account, coverage, and reserves equivalent to the account(s), coverage(s) and reserve(s) required by the outstanding ordinance(s).

SECTION 9

AUTHORIZATION OF MAYOR TO EXECUTE LOAN AGREEMENTS

The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute the Loan Agreements with the IEPA. The Council may authorize by resolution a person other than the Mayor for the sole purpose of authorizing or executing any documents associated with payment requests or reimbursements from the IEPA in connection with the Loan Agreements.

SECTION 10

SEVERABILITY

If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 11

REPEALER

All ordinances, resolutions or orders, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

EXHIBIT A

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE BONDS AND RIGHT TO FILE PETITION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, pursuant to Ordinance Number _____, adopted on _____, 2026 (the "*Ordinance*"), the City of Rockford, Winnebago and Ogle Counties, Illinois (the "*City*"), intends to issue its waterworks revenue bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$55,000,000 (the "*Bonds*") and bearing interest per annum at not to exceed the maximum rate authorized by law at the time of sale thereof, for the purpose of paying costs of improving the waterworks system of the City (the "*System*"), as further described in the Ordinance. The Bonds would be payable solely from the revenues of the System. A complete copy of the Ordinance accompanies this notice.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that if a petition signed by 9,326 or more electors of the City (being equal to 10% of the registered voters in the City), requesting that the question of improving the System and the issuance of the Bonds therefor, be submitted to the electors of the City is filed with the City Clerk within 30 days after the date of publication of the Ordinance and this Notice, then the question of improving the System and the issuance of the Bonds therefor shall be submitted to the electors of the City on the 3rd day of November, 2026, unless none of the electors of the City are scheduled to cast votes for any candidates for nomination for, election to or retention in public office at said election, in which case an election on the proposition to issue said bonds shall be held on the 8th day of November, 2026. The Circuit Court may declare that an emergency referendum should be held prior to either of said election dates pursuant to the provisions of Section 2A-1.4 of the Election Code of the State of Illinois, as amended. If not such petition is filed within said 30-day period, then the City shall thereafter be authorized to issue the Bonds. A petition form is available from the City Clerk at City Hall.
